

Course: Tactical Firearms Instructor

Length: 5 days

This course is designed to provide students with the information to develop and instruct firearms training programs. Students will be required to show proficiency with semi-auto handgun, revolver, and shotgun. Students will have two attempts and must pass a shooting evaluation on the first day with a passing score of at least 90% in order to continue in the course. This is not a learn how to shoot type of course; you should have a solid understanding of the fundamentals before attending. It is a learn how to teach others to shoot.

The major topics of the course:

- Drawing from holster
- Reloading
- Malfunction clearing
- Mindset

- Low light tactics

- EYE / EAR protection
- Holster and ammunition carrier for all handguns.
- Auto-pistol (at least 9mm) with three magazines and Revolver (at least .38 caliber).
- 12ga. police type shotgun with tactical sling.
- 700 rounds of factory loaded pistol ammunition for semi-auto handgun.
- 300 rounds of factory loaded ammunition for revolver.
- 25 rounds 00 buckshot, 100 rounds light target load / birdshot, 20 Rifled Slugs for shotgun.
- Handheld flashlight (weapon lights are also allowed, but you will need a handheld light).
- Cleaning and maintenance kits for all weapons.

• Appropriate clothing for range/classroom and weather, and water to drink and any snacks you want.

Evaluation Process:

In order to successfully complete the course the student will be evaluated on the following:

Marksmanship:

The student will be required to shoot three courses of fire

(revolver/semi-auto handgun/shotgun) on the first day with a passing score of at least 90%. The student will get two attempts to pass on each course of fire. If the student is unable to achieve 90%, then they will not be allowed to continue in the course.

Safety / Gun-Handling Skills:

The student will be evaluated on the proper and safe handling of weapons during all live-fire and dry-fire exercises. PASS/FAIL

Tactical Shooting:

The student will be evaluated during low-light / dynamic / and scenario situations. PASS/FAIL

Range Operations:

The student will be required to develop a qualification course of fire meeting TCOLE standards and conduct this course of fire at the range during live fire exercises. The student will be evaluated on Range Commands, Observation / Safety Skills, and Topic Presentation. PASS/FAIL

Written Examination:

The student will be required to pass a written examination with a score of at least 80%.


